

# No personnel from PAC to be deputed to civil police: UP govt

The Uttar Pradesh government has decided to end the decades-old practice of deputing Provincial Armed Constabulary (PAC) personnel to the civil police force. It has also directed authorities concerned to prepare a proposal to ensure equal promotion opportunities for employees of both forces.

This comes after CM Yogi Adityanath's directive to withdraw an order from DGP headquarters, quashing promotions of 896 PAC personnel in the civil police force. PAC personnel got promoted to ranks of head constable or sub-inspector. However, they were demoted once they came back to PAC.

Taking cognizance, the CM directed authorities to ensure promotion of personnel as per rules. He said the decision to demote them was taken without informing the government and said such actions affect the force's morale.

# Lucknow activist held over call to prayers against Macron

THE LUCKNOW Police and the UP Anti-Terrorism Squad (ATS) have arrested a 52-year-old activist for allegedly circulating WhatsApp messages asking people to observe special prayers in all mosques on Friday and raise black flags in their houses and shops against the French President," said Thakur.

"ATS officials were also present there (at his house). The rest was done by Lucknow Police, including registering the case, as this is a law and order issue. In the coming days, we will provide more help if asked," he added.

Hasanganj SHO, Amar Nath Verma, however, said the operation was carried out by the "special forces" — meaning ATS — and that they took Siddiqui into custody.

"When people started creating ruckus, we were called to the spot," he said. Following over Siddiqui to the police, ATS is learnt to have questioned him. DCP (central) Somen Barma said the FIR has been registered under IPC sections 153 A (promoting enmity between different

groups), 505 (statements conducive to public mischief) and 120B (criminal conspiracy).

Meanwhile, Siddiqui's daughter Zainab, also an activist, alleged that the police personnel beat up the family members with canes and detained her father without any explanation. In a video that is making rounds on social media, policemen can be purportedly seen using force.

"Around 5.30 pm, police came to my house, showed my photograph and asked if I was involved in the anti-CAA protest. I was not home, and my father denied my involvement. The police then left. But when I came back around an hour later, they reached my house and caught my father who had returned from namaz. I kept asking who they were and why they were arresting my father. The policemen beat up my minor sister and my brothers. They beat up the women with sticks and abused us," she said.

DCP Barma denied the allegations and said no force was used.

# Most OROP beneficiaries from UP, Punjab: Centre

THE CENTRE Friday released data for pension paid under the One Rank One Pension scheme since 2014. The government said in a statement that Rs 10,795.4 crore has been disbursed to 20,60,220 defence forces pensioners and family pensioners as arrears on account of the implementation of OROP.

"The yearly recurring expenditure on account of OROP is about Rs 7,123.38 crores and for about six years," the statement said. The total recurring expenditure "worked out to approximately Rs 42,740.28 crore".

The Centre said OROP beneficiaries "also got the benefit of fixation of pension under 7th CPC [Central Pay Commission] while calculating the pension by multiplication factor of 2.57".

# Govt betrayed armed forces with proposal to cut pension: Cong

THE CONGRESS on Friday accused the government of "betraying" the armed forces with its proposal to reduce pension entitlements for personnel who have served for less than 35 years. The opposition party asked PM Narendra Modi to clarify his stand on the issue and reject the proposal by the Department of Military Affairs (DMA).

The proposal — to increase retirement age across all ranks below Lieutenant General and implement a mechanism to cut premature pension — could get government sanction soon, as reported by *The Indian Express*.

Congress communication department head Randeep Surjewala alleged that the government often seeks votes on the sacrifice of the soldiers. "Now it has become the first regime in India's history to steal the pension and alternate career choice of officers after active service," he said. "The Prime Minister has exhorted the nation to light a diya for the soldiers, but has ensured darkness in their lives by attempting to reduce their pension by half," he added.

"At the time of recruitment in the Army... every officer in the Indian Military Academy has to compulsorily sign a 20-year mandatory service bond. An officer after 20 years of rigorous service, presently gets 50 per cent of their last drawn salary as pension, but the Modi government's new proposal is snatching away 50 per cent of that. How can the government change the service condition and modify the terms of service of military officers with 'back date'?"

According to the DMA proposal, pension entitlements for premature retirement of personnel should be half of the entitled pension after 20 to 25 years of service, 60 per cent of entitled pension after 26 to 30 years of service. It suggests that personnel who have completed 31 to 35 years of service should get 75 per cent of entitled pension, and those who have completed 35 years or more in service will get full pension.

Surjewala said 90 per cent of Army officers retire before 35 years of service and hence, this proposal would demoralise the forces.

# Shringla to visit Maldives next week, call on Solih

FOREIGN SECRETARY Harsh Vardhan Shringla will pay a two-day visit to Maldives next week during which he will hold talks with the top leadership of that country to review the entire gamut of bilateral ties and discuss the coronavirus situation, including India's assistance in Maldives' post-COVID economic recovery.

Ministry of External Affairs spokesperson Anurag Srivastava said that Shringla will visit

Maldives from November 9 to 10 and underlined that this would be the first high-level in-person interaction between the two countries since the disruption caused by the pandemic.

The foreign secretary is scheduled to call on President Ibrahim Solih and will have sub-

stantive discussions with the ministers of foreign affairs, defence, finance, economic development, planning, human affairs, tourism and youth and sports, he said. The foreign secretary will also call on Maldives' People's Majlis Speaker Mohamed Nasheed.

Concretization around trees is harmful for root aeration and also for percolation of water. It could lead to untimely death of the tree. It is, therefore, brought to the notice of all Govt. Department under GNCTD, Municipal Agencies, Corporations, Cantonment board, autonomous bodies, all departments & agencies of Government of India. State Governments and General Public that concretization of trees not only damages the tree, but also is an offence under Section 8 of Delhi Preservation of Trees Act, 1994, and also amounts to violation of Hon'ble NGT's orders.

The area within 1 (one) meter radius of the trunk of trees should be left de-concretized around the base of the tree while constructing, the pavements or roads to facilitate percolation of water to the roots. The area should be leveled with soil and grass may be planted, if need be.

All Civic Agencies, Govt. Departments, RWAs & individuals may please ensure removal of all the sign boards, names, advertisements, any kind of boards or signages, electric wires and high tension cables etc. placed on trees within their jurisdiction control failing which, a suitable penalty as per rules shall be imposed upon them for causing damage to trees. The person/ agency/ firm/ company etc whose advertisement or bill board etc is found on the trees shall also be prosecuted and/ or a suitable penalty as per rules shall be imposed upon him.

De-concretization should be done around trees which are already concretized, manually without the use of JCB machines etc so that the roots of trees are not damaged. During fresh construction of roads/ pavements, the Govt. Departments may add a fresh clause in their tender documents that an area within at least 1 (one) meter radius of the trunk of trees shall be left de-concretized/ soil filled.

## Major networks cut away from Trump's baseless fraud claims

**THE THREE BIG** broadcast networks - ABC, CBS and NBC - cut away from President Trump's news conference at the White House on Thursday as the president lobbied false claims about the integrity of the election.

Trump timed his appearance to air during the networks' evening newscasts, which draw the biggest collective audience in TV news. But the anchors broke in after a few minutes to correct some of his falsehoods.

"We have to interrupt here, because the president made a number of false statements, including the notion that there has been fraudulent voting," said Lester Holt, the "NBC Nightly News" anchor. He added, "There has been no evidence of that."

On ABC, the anchor David Muir broke in and told viewers "there's a lot to unpack here and fact-check." The CBS correspondent Nancy Cordes spent about 90 seconds ticking through several of Trump's baseless statements.

Although the cable news networks CNN and Fox News continued carrying Trump's remarks live, the decision by the broadcast networks to break away deprived Trump of a significantly larger audience for his unfiltered - and un-fact-checked - remarks on the election. The three network evening newscasts are seen by a larger and broader viewership than the programming on CNN, MSNBC and Fox News at that hour.

The question of whether to air Trump's appearances live has bedeviled television executives since the start of his presidency.

Earlier this year, networks struggled with how to contextualise information from Trump about the coronavirus that doctors and public health officials considered misleading and sometimes downright wrong.

## Counties with worst virus surges voted Trump overwhelmingly

**US VOTERS WENT** to the polls starkly divided on how they see President Donald Trump's response to the coronavirus pandemic, with a surprising twist: In places where the virus is most rampant now, Trump enjoyed enormous support.

An Associated Press analysis reveals that in 376 counties with the highest number of new cases per capita, the overwhelming majority - 93 per cent of those counties - went for Trump, a rate above other less severely hit areas. Most were rural areas in the Dakotas, Montana, Nebraska, Wisconsin and Iowa.

Taking note of the contrast, state health officials are pausing for a moment of introspection. Even as they worry about rising numbers of hospitalisations and deaths, they hope to reframe their messages and aim for a reset on public sentiment now that the election is



over.

"Public health officials need to step back, listen to and understand the people who aren't taking the same stance" on mask-wearing and other control measures, said Dr Marcus Plescia of the Association of State and Territorial Health Officials.

"I think there's the potential for things to get less charged and divisive," he said,

adding that there's a chance a retooled public health message might unify Americans around lowering case counts so hospitals won't get swamped during the winter months.

The AP's analysis was limited to counties in which at least 95 per cent of precincts had reported results, and grouped counties into six categories based on the rates of Covid-19 cases they'd experienced per 100,000 residents.

Polling, too, shows voters who split on Republican Trump vs Democrat Joe Biden differed on whether the pandemic is under control.

Thirty-six per cent of Trump voters described the pandemic as completely or mostly under control, and another 47 per cent said it was somewhat under control, according to AP VoteCast, a nationwide survey of more than 110,000 voters conducted for the AP by NORC at the University of Chicago.

## Weigh-scale cluster in Gujarat facing double whammy of Covid

**WEIGH-SCALE MANUFACTURING** cluster developed in Saurashtra region of Gujarat is facing double whammy of electronic weigh-scale (made by imported Chinese parts) and Covid-19 pandemic as the cluster is witnessing nearly 40 to 45 per cent drop in demand.

More than 300 units, mostly MSMEs, have thrived in and around Savarkundla town of Amreli district in the region. With the advent of electronic weigh-scales, overall demand of traditional weigh-scale started falling, but somehow,

the units survived by expanding markets across India, Africa and South East Asian countries. However, the outbreak of Covid-19, only added salt on their wounds, as the demand of weigh-scales dropped drastically to half.

"Demand of traditional weigh-scales was maintained despite tough competition from electronic weigh-scale due to lower prices. Price of electronic weigh-scale is more than three times higher than the manual weigh-scales," says Jayantibhai Makwana, president of Scale Manufacturers Association of Savarkundla adding that compared to pre-

**On an average, the Savarkundla weigh-scale cluster produces around 10,000 manual and nearly 3,000 electronic weigh-scales per day**

Coronavirus pandemic, demand of manual weigh-scales has dropped to almost half. Due to constraints of transportation and overall slowdown there are very few buyers even in the domestic market.

With over Rs. 700 crore annual turnover, the weigh-scale cluster developed in and around Savarkundla town, hav-

ing hardly 1.5 lakh population is providing direct and indirect employment to over 30,000 people. However, owners of the manual weigh-scale manufacturing units fearing loss of jobs as many units have started producing electronic weigh-scales which require less manpower.

Hitesh Dodia, an owner of weigh-scale units says that 80 per cent raw materials for the electronic weigh-scale including load cells, motherboard, display etc are being imported from China. "We only have to assemble electronic weigh-scale. The process is much faster and it doesn't require skilled manpower."

## Gender salary gap narrows only marginally in Europe

**THE PAY GAP** between men and women doing the same job in Europe narrowed only marginally this year, the European Commission said on Friday, even though a vast majority of EU citizens support eliminating that difference.

A woman doing the same job as a man is still getting 14.1% less money for it, a small improvement on the 14.5% last year.

"Women are not equally valued for their work. They still earn on average 86 cents for every euro a man earns across Europe," the Commission said in a statement issued on Friday. "Women thus work 51 days more to earn the same as their male colleagues," the Commission said in the statement.

## GM thinks big in China with plans to import SUVs

**GENERAL MOTORS PLANS** to sell full-size sport-utility vehicle (SUV) models in China for the first time, and will import a range of models to beef up its product lineup into the world's biggest car market, its China chief told Reuters.

The plan would mark a change of tack for GM, which currently produces all of the vehicles it sells in China within the country, which is set to be the only major economy to grow this year amid the Covid-19 pandemic.

GM, China's second-biggest foreign automaker, is aiming to offer four models as it looks to improve its brand image and support a sales recovery: Chevrolet's Tahoe and Suburban, Cadillac's Escalade and the GMC Yukon Denali.

The Detroit-based company is showcasing those models at the China International Import Expo, or CIIE, an annual import show in Shanghai which started on Wednesday and runs into next week.

"Our intention is to get customer reaction and find a way to sell these cars in China," said GM's China chief Julian Blissett.

The automaker sees opportunities for such vehicles, partly because Chinese families are expanding, he added.

"We are looking into a variety of market sales plans for these vehicles, including online sales, leasing and others," he said, declining to give a detailed timeframe for the plan.

GM's Buick and Cadillac mid-size SUVs helped the group's Chinese sales grow 12% in the third quarter this year, the first quarterly growth in the past two years.

But it does not have full-size SUV models, which usually have a third row of seats and has room for six or seven people.

China, where over 25 million vehicles were sold last year, is a crucial battleground for global automakers including Volkswagen AG, the biggest foreign player by sales volumes, GM and Toyota as well as local leaders Geely and Great Wall.
