10 Nepali nationals held for obtaining Aadhaar illegally

Mumbai: Mumbai Police's Crime Branch arrested 10 Nepali nationals for allegedly obtaining Aadhaar cards using forged documents. Last week, two persons, who were part of a company that was contracted by a large public sector bank to issue Aadhaar cards, were arrested. The duo, Vinod Chavan and Umesh Chaudhary, forged documents for those who did not have the necessary papers to get Aadhaar cards. The duo would produce forged documents and charge Rs 5,000-7,000 to obtain Aadhaar cards. "Ten Nepali nationals with passports had procured Aadhaar cards illegally. They were arrested," said DCP (Crime Branch) Akbar Pathan.

Several banks and post offices are allowed to issue Aadhaar cards by the UIDAI, and some banks outsource the work to other companies. Here, the duo were employees of FIA Technology Services Pvt Ltd. Police are probing if there was any negligence on the bank's part that led to the duo issuing Aadhaar cards using forged documents. *ENS*

Porn movies racket: Another in police net

MUMBAI POLICE'S crime branch, which is investigating the case of porn movies' production, on Wednesday arrested another person from Surat, taking the total number of arrests to nine.

Police said the accused, identified as Tanvir Hashmi alias Tan (40), directed some porn movies and sold them to a few OTT platforms that were involved in showing porn and semi-porn films, an officer said. Some of these movies were also shot in Surat, the officer added. Prior to this, eight persons, including small-time actress Gehna Vasisth, were arrested by the crime branch in this case. Police on Friday raided a bungalow in Madh where a porn film was allegedly being shot and arrested five persons, including two male actors, a photographer, a cameraman and a director.

Broadcasting porn is illegal in India. Police added that some women are forced to act in these films as they feature as regular web series. Some of these movies were also sent to a production house in the UK where they were uploaded.

Man 'caught with drugs' gets bail as police fail to submit chemical report

ASPECIAL court in Thane granted bail to a man who was allegedly caught with a banned drug, as police failed to submit a chemical analyser's report of the seized substance. The court rapped police and stated it had "forgotten to deal with the investigation seriously".

"It is very important to note the investigating agency, while dealing with such serious offences, have forgotten to deal with the investigation seriously. It appears they have lost sight of the problem of drug addicts, (which) is international and the mafia is working throughout the world. It is a crime against the society and it has to be dealt with iron hands. Use of drugs by young people across the globe has increased," the court said.

police in Navi Mumbai in October last year along with another man, Mithun Poojari. Police claimed a search led them to packets containing a white powder, which was established to be methamphetamine after a field test. Police

claimed a "huge quantity" - 94 grams, worth up to Rs 4.7 lakh - of the powder was seized from both men. Samples of the powder were sent to a forensic lab to confirm the field test's findings. The accused in their bail plea said a chargesheet filed against them did not include the forensic report, and therefore the prosecution's case remains inconclusive about whether the powder was a banned drug.

The court said the prosecution had not even placed on record the results of the field test and a reference to methamphetamine in the panchnama is not sufficient to keep the man behind bars.

"In absence of any field test report or CA (chemical analysers) report of suspected substance, (it) definitely causes prejudice to the prosecution and more probably to the accused. This is also one of the reasons for delay in trial," the court said while allowing bail to the accused on a surety of Rs 2 lakh.

Kangana to apply to BMC for regularisation, withdraw plea

ACTOR KANGANA Ranaut sought to withdraw an appeal against the Dindoshi civil court order that had dismissed her plea against the 2018 Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) notice over alleged irregularities at her Khar residential home. On Wednesday, Ranaut told the Bombay High Court through senior counsel Birendra Saraf that she would instead file a regularisation application before the BMC in connection with the alleged irregularities.

On February 2, Ranaut had sought from the High Court a further stay on the demolition, stating

ing that the BMC's action against her was "vendetta" and sought time from the court to give information regarding her application for regularisation of the "illegal portion" of her premises. The court had then continued interim protection to Ranaut till further hearing.

On Wednesday, a single judge bench of Justice Prithviraj K Chavan permitted Ranaut to

withdraw the appeal and said that no coercive action be taken by the civic body till the application of regularisation is considered and decided. The court also said that for two weeks thereafter, Ranaut would be allowed file an appeal in case of an adverse order on her regularisation application.

"The appellant (Ranaut) is permitted to apply for regularisation before the BMC within a period of four weeks," the judge said, adding that the civic body shall decide the same expeditiously and in accordance with the law.

"In case of any adverse order against the appellant, no coercive action shall be taken two weeks thereafter by the BMC to enable

the appellant to file appeal," the HC said.

The Dindoshi civil court on December 22, 2020 had dismissed a notice of motion filed by Ranaut against a 2018 BMC notice for alleged violation and irregularities at her Khar home.

Ranaut, through her lawyers, had approached the civil court in January 2019, challenging the notice and seeking orders to restrain the BMC from taking any coercive step. The court had then ordered both parties to maintain the status quo. On December 22, while dismissing her plea, the court extended interim protection against coercive action for another six weeks to enable her to file an appeal before the High Court, which the actor did last month.

Four booked for manhandling traffic cop

THE MARINE Drive police have booked four persons for allegedly manhandling a traffic police constable after he clamped their vehicles for parking in a no-parking zone. The incident happened during a drive the traffic authorities have launched against illegal parking.

At F-road in Marine Drive on February 4, traffic authorities clamped the wheels of vehicles parked illegally. "Around 15 vehicles were clamped. While most

owners paid the fine and left with their vehicles, as the owners of four vehicles did not show up, the traffic officials left for Colaba division office," said an official.

Two hours later, the constable was contacted by the owners after which he went to the spot. However, the owners, who are also residents of F-road, started arguing with the constable. "The four then manhandled him and stopped him from leaving after which he contacted the control room," said an official. The constable then lodged a complaint at Marine Drive police station.

The police said the four have

been booked under IPC sections 353 (assault or criminal force to deter public servant from discharge of his duty), 341 (wrongful restraint), 427 (mischief causing damage to the amount of fifty rupees), 506 (criminal intimidation) and 34 (common intention).

Senior police inspector Vishwanath Kolekar of Marine Drive police station said, "We registered the case on the basis of the constable's statement. We are investigating the matter."

In yet another incident at RTO road in Tardeo, the residents of Jariwala building had a confrontation with policemen who

clamped their vehicles parked on the road. Naresh Khedekar, a resident, said, "This building is more than 100 years old and vehicles are being parked on this road since people started staying here. Nobody has ever come and fined us. Suddenly some traffic policemen show up and clamp our vehicles. We should have been notified beforehand that parking here is no more allowed."

DCP (traffic headquarters) Nandkumar Thakur said, "Parking on any road in Mumbai is illegal unless there is special permission from the traffic department or the BMC."
