Women's prayer for equality

Catholics unhappy with Vatican's stand on female priests and bishops

WHAT WOC HAS SAID...

- For the synodal process to retain credibility, it will need to take seriously the full equality of women and LGBTQ+ people in every aspect of church life.
- If the synod actually did not notice the urgent cries, prayers, and hopes of women, or is unwilling to take concrete steps to dismantle church structures and policies that oppress and diminish women, WOC and its supporters will simply need to make themselves even more visible.
- While the meeting acknowledged the "wounds women have experienced at the hands of the church", it fell short of engaging substantially with the healing of those wounds.

"What irked people is that the church opened up the dicatone to married men. Women have been saying 'Why only married men?'" said Dr Astrid Lobo Gajiwala, a church leader from Mumbai and a leading voice for gender equality in the church.

The question remains that you should not be discriminated against in terms of gender: All leadership roles are linked to ordination," she said.

Other Christian denominations have been faster in bringing in reforms to bring women to the top tier hierarchy. The Anglican Church, and one of its counterparts in India, the Church of South India, have already appointed women as bishops and priests.

There are other women in the church who want to be hopeful and patient. Sister Nirmalini, the head of the Apostolic Carmel order who attended the Vatican meeting, said that she believes women will see to the increased focus on women's "deserving dignity". She said, "I need to be, however patient to see the day when the points mentioned in the document, particularly about women, will percolate down at all levels of the church."

Help held for siphoning ₹10L from producer

A man, who worked as domestic help at a film producer's house in Andheri, has been arrested for allegedly siphoning Rs10.5 lakh, informed the DN Nagar police. Suresh Irfan Javed, 23, was caught on Tuesday around a week after the offence was registered.

According to Rameesh Jagdish Sharma, 65, the accused is the son of his

former domestic help and was working for him for the past five years. The producer said that he completely trusted Javed hence he used to

lend his mobile phone so that he could call his relatives. Taking advantage of the same, Javed downloaded the PhonePe app and used it to siphon funds from Shar-

ma's account. To leave no trace of the crime, he always deleted the app after transferring the money, said the police, adding that the trans-

ferred in his account.

The fraud came to fore when Sharma's landlord called him to inform that the cheque given by him for rent payment had bounced. Immediately, the producer checked his bank statement and found that several lakhs of rupees had been transferred within his knowledge. After doing further, he discovered that the account was in Javed's name. The siphoned fund has been frozen, the police said.

Making use of enemies

Maharashtra MLA Rajshekhar Shinde has written to Maharashtra Governor Ramesh Bais, drawing his attention to an X (formerly Twitter) handle @numba71, which has made extremely serious allegations of corruption against three officials of the Maharashtra State Road Development Corporation. Shinde has alleged that there is a deep nexus between these officials and certain contractors executing projects for the corporation. The letter has sent a shiver down the spines of not only these three officials but also others against whom there is a needle of suspicion, especially because the @numba71 handle is used by hardline pro-BJP followers; hence, it's also surprising that Shaikh, who belongs to the Samajwadi Party, has taken up the issue. It is learnt that Governor Bais has forwarded the letter to Chief Minister Eknath Shinde, but the matter has not moved further. It is said the government is totally unaware of the matter and has not found time to probe the alleged scam that is said to be running into a few thousand crore rupees.

Beat the bond

Even though the Attorney General R Venkateswaran told the Supreme Court recently that citizens do not have a right to information under Article 19(1)(g), the Constitution allows donations received by political parties, many companies are now re-thinking about buying electoral bonds from State Bank of India, which alone is authorised to receive any amount of cash towards the purchase of these bonds. It is true that Apple itself has diluted its warning by saying that it could be a "false alarm". The alacrity with which the Modi government agreed to a probe and its invitation to Apple to join the investigation suggests that the regime has done its homework. In any case, it will be interesting to know the outcome of the probe. Will the opposition have egg on its face?
