Catholics unhappy with Vatican's stand on female priests and bishops

Catholic women from Num-bai campaigning for equality in the church's religious lile-archy are unhappy with the recently concluded meeting of bishops in the Vatican be-cause the event has not pro-duced a clear statement on the size of ordaining women as priests and bishops. WHAT WOC HAS SAID ...

For the synodal process to retain credibility, it will need to take seriously the full equality of women and LGBTQ+ people in every aspect of church life.

If the synod assembly did not notice the urgent cries, prayers, and hopes of women, or is unwilling to take concrete steps to dismantle church structures and policies that oppress and diminish women, WOC and its supporters will simply need to make themselves even more visible.

While the meeting acknowledged the "wounds women experienced at the hands of the church", it fell short of engaging substantially with the healing of those wounds.
