DESHMUKH GRAFT CASE

Conducted searches at 12 locations in 8 cities: CBI

THE CENTRAL Bureau of Investigation (CBI) on Wednesday said it has conducted searches at 12 locations in eight cities, including Mumbai, Pune, Nashik, Sangli, Ahmednagar and Osmanabad, in connection with the alleged corruption case against former Maharashtra home minister Anil Deshmukh.

The CBI raids took place three days before the Supreme Court is due to hear Deshmukh's petition on July 30, requesting a fair investigation in the case.

CBI sources said searches were conducted on the premises of a few police officers, including Assistant Superintendent of Police Sanjay Patil, Deputy Superintendent of Police Raju Bhujbal and a few middlemen on July 27, in connection with the case.

Meanwhile, the Enforcement Directorate (ED), which is also probing the case, has allegedly established money laundering of over Rs 80 crore by him, sources said. Last month, the ED probe found that Deshmukh, while acting as the home minister of Maharashtra, "received illegal gratification of approximately Rs 4.7 crore in cash from various orchestra bar owners" through now dismissed Mumbai Police officer Sachin Waze, arrested in the Ambani terror scare case.

According to the ED, Deshmukh's family "laundered the tainted sum of Rs 4.18 crore

SGNP allows wildlife enthusiasts to adopt animals for one year

TO INVOLVE more people in the conservation of wildlife, the Sanjay Gandhi National Park (SGNP) has invited citizens, corporates and institutions to adopt 25 animals, including lions, tigers, and leopards, housed in captivity at the park for one year upon paying an adoption fee.

The adoption scheme, which aims to attract more visitors to the park and make them more aware of the wild animals, allows the adopters to visit the adoptee animal once a week without paying any special fees.

Under the scheme, a tiger can be adopted for Rs 3.10 lakh, lion for Rs 3 lakh, leopard for Rs 1.20 lakh, rusty-spotted cat for Rs 50,000, Blue Bull for Rs 30,000, spotted deer for Rs 20,000 and barking deer for Rs 10,000 for one year. The money thus obtained is used for the upkeep of the animals.

Till last year, only 20 animals had been adopted under the scheme at a total cost of Rs 16.6 lakh annually.

PHONE-TAPPING CASE

'Arbitrary' FIR lodged to suppress crime, prevent prosecution of offenders: Shukla

SEEKING THAT the FIR in the alleged illegal phone-tapping case registered against her by the Mumbai Police be quashed, senior IPS officer Rashmi Shukla submitted Wednesday before the Bombay High Court that the "arbitrary" case had been lodged to "suppress the crime and not to investigate and prosecute offenders" who were indulging in corrupt practices in postings of the police officers.

Senior advocate Mahesh Jethmalani, representing Shukla, submitted before the court that his client was being made a "scapegoat" and "harassed" through the probe for being "honest" and unearthing corruption involved in postings and transfer of senior police officers.

A division bench of Justices S S Shinde and N J Jamadar was hearing a plea by Shukla against the FIR lodged under the Official

Department.

The alleged tapping of phones had taken place when Shukla headed the SID. Shukla is currently serving as additional director general of the Central Reserve Police Force's (CRPF) South Zone and is posted in Hyderabad.

Jethmalani said the then Maharashtra director general of police (DGP) had asked Shukla to carry out surveillance and she

was merely following his directives and had taken requisite permission from then state additional chief secretary Sitaram Kunte as per the Indian Telegraph Act.

"The numbers belonged to a few brokers of certain politicians involved in corruption and demanding massive monetary compensation for plum postings and transfers. They were allegedly taking instructions from top government officials and had political connections," Jethmalani submitted.

"Interception, with due permissions to prevent crime, is a valid ground for interception of wireless messages," he said and sought that FIR against Shukla be quashed. The plea also sought that the probe is transferred to the CBI.

The court adjourned the hearing on Shukla's plea to August 5 after the state assured the HC that no coercive steps, including arrest, will be taken against her till August 6.

Preliminary probes by govt to scuttle CBI investigation into allegations against Deshmukh: Param Bir to HC

FORMER MUMBAI Police commissioner Param Bir Singh, while seeking quashing of two preliminary inquiries initiated against him by the Maharashtra government, told the Bombay High Court on Wednesday that the probes were initiated to scuttle the CBI investigation ordered by the HC on April 5 following his allegations of corruption against former state home minister Anil Deshmukh.

However, questioning the maintainability of the petition, the Maharashtra government said that Singh's contentions pertaining to preliminary inquiries come under the purview of the All India Services (Conduct) Rules, which are dealt by the Central Administrative Tribunal (CAT).

A division bench of Justices S S Shinde and N J Jamadar was hearing Singh's plea challenging two preliminary inquiries initiated against him in connection to the Ambani terror scare case and the allegations made by Inspector Anup Dange, who was suspended last year and has been recently reinstated by the Mumbai Police.

Senior advocate Mahesh Jethmalani, representing Singh,

said that both the probes were initiated hastily and without application of mind. "It is obvious from the circumstances that it was issued out of confusion and vendetta. Singh complained against Anil Deshmukh and instead of inquiring into that, the state has punished the whistleblower... They are trying to shoot the messenger," Jethmalani argued.

He added that it was not "mere administrative inquiry" but also dealt with the criminal aspect of the case and the same was arbitrary and against the law.

Senior counsel Darius Khambata, representing Maharashtra, said that the petition pertained to "service matters" and should be raised before CAT. Opposing Singh's contention that the government action was a form of vendetta, Khambata said that the complaint was lodged by Dange in February, long before Singh's March 20 letter to the government accusing Deshmukh of corruption.

Govt not cooperating in probe against Deshmukh, says CBI

The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) told the Bombay High Court Wednesday the Maharashtra government was not cooperating with the central agency and not handing over the documents pertaining to the FIR it had registered against the former state home minister, Anil Deshmukh, and unknown others on April 21.

Additional Solicitor General Anil Singh, appearing for the CBI, told a division bench of Justices S S Shinde and N J Jamadar that the state government was acting against the July 22 HC order, which dismissed

Deshmukh's plea and said the CBI can legitimately inquire into allegations of corruption in police transfers and postings having nexus with alleged offences against Deshmukh and his associates.

Singh said that the CBI, on July 23, had written a letter to the state's intelligence department seeking copies and information pertaining to the letter/report by senior IPS officer Rashmi Shukla regarding corruption in transfers and postings of police officers. However, the state has refused to hand over the same.

The court asked CBI to file separate short application raising contentions, after which it would hear the contentions and decide the plea.

Five members of family injured as three-storey building collapses on Andheri house

FIVE MEMBERS of a family were injured after a three-storey building under construction collapsed on their house at Juhu Gully in Andheri in the wee hours of Wednesday.

According to BMC's Disaster Management Cell, the incident happened around 12.30 am when the four-storey structure at Mehtab Baba Chawl collapsed on an adjoining house, where the injured - Akbar Shaikh (60), Shamsuddin Shaikh (50), Chand Shaikh (34), Arif Shaikh (17) and Ajara Shaikh (18) - lived.

The injured were taken to Cooper hospital for treatment. Officials from BMC said they are stable.

A member of the fire brigade carrying out a search and rescue operation at the collapse site also sustained minor injuries, said officials.
