3. How much dividend will be paid?

Fully paid-up shares – ₹10/- per share Partly paid-up shares (₹2.504 per share paid-up) – ₹2.504/- per share

4. What are the book closure days?

9. If I want to speak at the AGM, what should I do?

The Members who would like to express their views or ask questions during the AGM may register themselves as a speaker by sending their request from their registered email address mentioning their name, DP ID and Client ID/folio number, PAN and mobile number at cosec@tatasteel.com between Friday, August 14, 2020 (9:00 a.m. IST) and Sunday, August 16, 2020 (5:00 p.m. IST). Only those Members who have pre-registered themselves as a speaker will be allowed to express their views/ask questions during the AGM. The Company reserves the right to restrict the number of speakers depending on the availability of time for the AGM.

10. How should the Institutional / Corporate Shareholders attend the AGM?

The Institutional/Corporate Shareholders (i.e. other than individuals / HUF, NRI, etc.) are required to send a scanned copy DF/JPG Format) of its Board or governing body Resolution/ Authorisation etc., authorising its representative to attend the AGM through VC/OAVM on its behalf and to vote through remote e-voting.
