Saradha chargesheet names ex-DGP, ex-MLA

New Delhi: The ED on Monday said it has filed a fresh chargesheet in the Saradha group money laundering case and named a former DGP and an ex-CPM MLA as accused.

Those named in the latest chargesheet for "acquiring" proceeds of crime are Rajat Kumar Majumder, former DGP of West Bengal armed police; Debendranath Biswas, former IPS officer and ex-CPM MLA; Debabrata Sarkar, executive committee member of the East Bengal Club; alleged middleman Sandhir Agarwal; Sajjan Agarwal; Naresh Balodia, advocate to Saradha Group chief Sudipto Sen; and Anubhuti Printers and Publication, owned by late Anjan Dutta, former Assam cabinet minister and state Congress chief.

Shah: Western states critical to economy, must focus on security

Gandhinagar: Member states of the Western Zonal Council that share long coastlines must focus on strengthening security given the presence of "highly sensitive institutions and industries" in a region with a contribution of 25% the country's GDP, Union home minister Amit Shah said in Gandhinagar on Monday.

"This region is the hub of finance, IT, the diamond sector, petroleum, automobile and defence. There is a need for sustained efforts towards ensuring tight security," Shah was quoted as saying at the 26th conclave of the zonal council. The chief ministers of Gujarat, Maharashtra and Goa, the administrator of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu, and several ministers and officials of the member states were at the conclave. Shah also asked the member states and Union territories to create the necessary basic infrastructure and capacity for implementation of three new bills brought by the Union government to replace British-era criminal procedure codes. The home minister inaugurated an e-resource web portal of Interstate Council Secretariat under the MHA to facilitate the functioning of zonal councils.

The zonal council meeting took up 17 issues, of which nine were resolved.

169 students of Sangli school take ill on being fed leftovers

Kolhapur: As many as 169 students of a government-aided ashram school fell ill after consuming leftover food in Umadi town of Jalgaon in Maharashtra's Sangli district on Sunday, reports Abhijeet Patil.

The students, who stay in the residential facility of the school, are all aged between 5 and 15 and mostly belong to poor families of vimukt jati and the nomadic tribe community. Food and sweet samples have been taken for analysis. All of them are currently stable and under observation at various hospitals. Some locals, who had a big function at their home on Sunday afternoon, had given the leftover food to the authorities of the ashram school. However, none of the guests, who had consumed the food at the function, have so far reported feeling unwell.

Vikramsinh Kadam, the civil surgeon of Sangli district, told TOI: "Initially, a few students started vomiting and complained of dysentery. They were first taken to a hospital. All are now out of danger. We they will be under observation till Tuesday morning."

CBI books ED official in Delhi excise case

Not On Probe Team But Met The Accused

New Delhi: Acting on a complaint from the Enforcement Directorate (ED) against an assistant director and a clerk of the enforcement agency and others, including the CEO of a 5-star hotel, the CBI has registered an FIR in a bribery case concerning an attempt to influence the money laundering probe into the Delhi liquor scam.

Besides Pawan Khatri, an assistant director with ED's Delhi zone, others accused in the CBI case are Birender Pal Singh, father of Amandeep Singh Dhall, one of the key accused in the "liquorgate"; Vikramaditya, CEO of the Claridges;

CBI registers 2nd case against Pune scientist

The CBI filed a second FIR against an Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology former scientist and three others for "causing huge wrongful loss to the institute and corresponding wrongful gains to themselves" in the procurement and installation of digital display system for SAFAR project in Ahmedabad in 2015-16. The scientist was in charge of System for Air Quality and Weather Forecasting and Research project between 2011 and 2018.

Deepak Sangwan, an assistant general manager with Air India; and Praveen Vats, a chartered accountant.

In the complaint lodged by ED's special director Sonia Narang with the CBI, it has been alleged that Vats, working through Sangwan and Vikramaditya, collected Rs 5 crore in multiple tranches from Singh to save latter's son Dhall from being arrested.

Khatri was not part of the probe team but, going by the FIR's contents, he allegedly organised papers related to the liquor scam probe and participated in meetings with other accused.

It was Vats who promised to help Singh for Rs 5 crore. The CA first took Rs 3 crore for saving Dhall from arrest. He then sought, and got, another Rs 2 crore from Singh for protection.

The problem arose when Dhall was arrested on March 1 and Singh asked for a refund. Vats and others told him that they had tried to help but Dhall was arrested because of instructions from higher authorities. The displeasure of Dhall's father led to a chain of meetings and reverse cash transactions, all of which have been recorded on the CCTV cameras.
