I. The Project proponent shall install 24x7 air monitoring devices to monitor air emissions, as provided by the CPCB and submit report to Ministry and its regional Office. II. Continuous stack monitoring facilities for all the stacks shall be provided and sufficient air pollution control devices viz. Electro Static Precipitator (ESP), bag house, bag filters etc, shall be provided to keep the emission levels below 50 mg / Nm3 and installing energy efficient technology. III. Positional Ambient Air Quality Emission Standards issued by the ministry vide G.S.R. no.826 (E) dated 16th November 2009 shall be followed. IV.
